Upper and lower field – 2,0 cm each; left – 3,0 cm; right – 1,5 cm; font type – Times New Roman; font size – 14; interval – 1,5. Illustrative material (if available) – one good quality drawing in JPEG format.

The collection of abstracts is planned to be published before the beginning of work of the scientific seminar.
